ALEXANDRE GUILMANT (1837-1911) was a French organist, composer, and teacher. He held prominent positions in Paris, serving as organist at the church of la Sainte-Trinité from 1871 to 1896 and teaching at the Paris Conservatoire, where he succeeded Charles-Marie Widor in 1896. Following his tenure at the church Guilmant pursued a career as a touring virtuoso, giving recitals in the United States and Canada as well as throughout Europe. Among his students are such famed organists as Marcel Dupré, Augustin Barié, and Joseph Bonnet.
