
## \*PRAYER OF CONFESSION (Unison)\*\*

THIS MORNING'S PRELUDE AND POSTLUDE are the remaining two parts of Johann Sebastian Bach's Toccata in C, perhaps more commonly known as the Toccata, Adagio, and Fugue. The toccata was played at Westminster this past Palm Sunday, and one may recall its improvisatory beginning and joyful, energetic counterpoint for the remainder of the movement. The adagio, heard today, is in the relative minor key and is a lovely and expressive melody over a steady, plaintive, almost hypnotic, pedal line and block chords in the left hand. The movement ends with a gravityfilled and harmonically dramatic few measures that sum up the extraordinarily deep beauty of this adagio. The fugue that follows is exuberant, uplifting, and dancing!
